This week we have been learning how to add and subtract amounts to and from 20. The calculations we have used have included using 3 or more numbers to make a total amount. We've also been applying our knowledge by problem solving. In English we have been writing rhyming poetry and looking for repetition and adjectives within poems based on farmyards. You'll be able to hear these poems at Harvest festival! Our phase 5 sound this week is the split digraph 'a_e'. We have enjoyed a science based forest schools this week where we named, sorted and found properties of natural materials.

Next week we will be starting to plan our new topic "Why does it get darker earlier in Winter?" We'll be thinking about seasonal changes.
