The children have been working on what makes a good sentence by looking at full stops, capital letters, finger spaces and the use of conjunctions within their writing. In Maths we have been learning to use a number line to compare numbers as well as ordering numbers to 100 and writing numbers to 20 as words. The children have enjoyed making models of owl boxes and paintings of owls in the creative corner as well as investigating sources of light and what is meant by transparent and opaque in Science.
