This week we have been learning to retell, sequence and order events in the story of the Three Little Pigs in English. We have also written our own story starters. In maths we have been ordering numbers to 20, focusing on place value and correct orientation of numbers. Our phase 5 sound this week is be 'ow/ou'.

Next week we will be investigating properties for materials and their uses in Science. Creating repeating patterns in Art and learning our Three Little pigs song in Music. We aim to complete our stories and will focus on counting in twos.
