Year One

This week we have been learning the alternative 'ai/ay/a-e' sounds in phase 5 phonics. In maths we have been representing numbers to 100, ordering and finding out about greater than and less than signs. We have started to learn about adjectives in English and had a go at writing a description of the Three Little Pigs and their houses. In Science we have been sorting and naming different types of materials.

Next week we will be learning retell, sequence and order events in the story of the Three Little Pigs in English. In maths we will be finding 1 more or less than a number and focus on place value. Our phase 5 sound will be 'ow/ou'. We will also be practicing our first 5 tricky spellings words.

To help you support your child at home I have provided you with a 'Year One support pack'. This includes maths targets, a reading book, online maths resource, common exception words lists, phase 5 sounds and spellings. Please see letters included in the pack for more information.

In Maths we have been looking at doubles and halves and challenging ourselves to half odd numbers. In Phonics we have been practicing adding the ed suffix to root words. Next week we will be learning about the value of two and three digit numbers in Maths and we will be using practical resources to help us. In English we will be re-writing the story of 'Harry and His Bucket Full of Dinosaurs'. We will be continuing our work on animal habitats in Science and in Phonics we will be practicing reading and spelling polysyllabic words.

To support your child at home you can ask them to put the following words into sentences: stopped, jumped, cried, lived and pulled.
