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Year 5

Another busy week in Year 5. In maths we have learnt the names and qualities of acute, right, obtuse and reflex angles. In English we have organised a text into paragraphs to distinguish between different information, events or processes. We then planned our own historical stories. In Art we have created some wonderful WW2 Blitz paintings with a silhouette of London.

Next week in English we will write our own stories with a historical setting. In Maths we will draw angles using a protractor, draw lines and angles with a high level of accuracy, investigate the angles of various quadrilaterals and solve problems involving angles.

To support your child at home, please spend time checking their homework. Their homework links to their learning in class so it is a great way to find out what they have been up to.

Year 6

This week has been a busy revision week in Year 6. We have reminded ourselves how to calculate with fractions, decimals and percentages and practised how to apply these skills when solving unfamiliar problems. We have also been looking at a range of graphs and charts and calculating averages from various sets of data. As part of our English work we have been reading the classic poem, 'The Raven' by Edgar Allan Poe and looking at the style and atmosphere created by the poem. Year 6 have written some fantastic poems in a similar style which we are looking forward to displaying and sharing with the school in the coming weeks.

There have been lots of questions about SATs week this week.

The children do not need to come to school any earlier than usual during SATs week, the doors will open at 8:45 and we will all have breakfast together before we start any papers. The test schedule is as follows: Monday - SPAG, Tuesday - Reading, Wednesday- Arithmetic and Reasoning 1, Thursday- Reasoning 2.
