Year 3

What a busy week we have had! We have been learning how to add and subtract lengths and solve problems involving mm, cm, and m. In English we have analysed good examples of persuasive texts and highlighting the key features. In science we investigated whether all metals were conductive of electricity.

Next week we will start to write our persuasive texts about giving to food banks. In maths we will be learning how to measure the perimeter of shapes and objects.

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Year 5

This week we have continued to multiply numbers up to 4 digits by a two-digit number using a written method. We have also worked on dividing numbers mentally, drawing upon known facts and dividing numbers up to 4 digits by a one-digit number. In English we have listened carefully in discussions, made contributions and asked questions. We have also developed our use of sentence starters to highlight main ideas.

Next week we will continue our learning on division by dividing numbers up to 4 digits by a one-digit number using the formal written method of short division. In English we will build ideas and plan for a balanced argument.

To support your child at home, please test them on their instant recall targets and their multiplication. This will help support their learning of division.

Year 6

This week we have been learning how to recognise and calculate decimal equivalences of fractions. The children have created their own games to help them remember and quickly recall these facts. To support your child at home you could play their game with them and help to embed this new knowledge.

In English we have been learning how to include grammatical features such as adverbials and noun phrases in our writing.

To support your child at home, please test them on their instant recall targets. These are crucial for fluency in their maths lessons.
