Year 3

What a wonderful week we have had yet again in Year 3! We have been learning the value of money up to £20 notes and what better way to do this than spend it in our Year 3 shop. The children were able to work out how much each item cost and then also finding different ways they could pay with coins and notes. In English we have started to write our explanation texts, with the children really thinking about their audience and adapting their writing accordingly.

Next week we will be learning how to add and subtract money using large values. In English we will be performing our explanation reports before starting a new topic on motivational half-time speeches for the upcoming Champions League.
