Year 3

This week we have been learning how to find ten and one hundred more or less than any number to one thousand. We have had great fun in the outdoors looking for number sequences and then ordering them. In English we have been writing story maps about the famous Roman myth of Romulus and Remus, the children have really enjoyed this story.

Next week we will continue with the place value of numbers and our focuses will be recognising the place value of each digit in a three digit number and comparing and ordering numbers to 1000. In English next week we will be going outside in the forest schools area to design and make our own mythical creatures.

To support your child at home please challenge them to count in 50s starting from any number. It is important that your child is heard to read daily, the children have all had new reading books.

Year 4

This week in year 4 we have been learning about space, we have used our mathematical skills to order the planets according to their diameter, using our knowledge of place value. In English we have been writing sci-fi stories. We have been working hard on including clauses in our sentences as well as similes to help add detail and description.

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Year 5

This week we have been learning to read, write, order and compare numbers to

1 000 000 using place value, pictorial representations and number lines. In English we have been identifying and understanding the use of flashbacks. We have watched the short film 'The Piano' which has supported our learning. In Science we have been identifying different forces acting on objects.

Next week we will be learning about number patterns that decrease in multiples of

10 000 or 100 000. We will also round numbers to the nearest 100, 1000, 10 000 and 100 000 using number lines and bar graphs. In English we will plan, write and edit our own Flashbacks and in Science we will be learning about the effect of gravity on unsupported objects.

To support your child at home you can listen to your child read, practise reading and partitioning 6 digit numbers and continue to work on instant recall targets.

Year 6

It has been a wonderful week in year 6, I have really enjoyed getting to know the children again and beginning to tackle the year 6 curriculum together. This week we have learnt about place value, using our knowledge to order, compare and round numbers. In English we have been reading Sherezade's tales and have started to plan our own interpretation of her 1001 tales. Next week we will begin to write our stories, exploring how we can select words and phrases for effect. In maths we will begin to look at the four operations and formal calculation methods. To support your child at home you can practice your times tables regularly and ask your child to log on to times table rock stars.
