Year 3

This week we have been learning number patterns that decrease in multiples of 10 000 or 100 000. We have also worked on negative and positive numbers and gone around school taking thermometer readings in different locations. We have also round numbers to the nearest 100, 1000, 10 000 and 100 000 using number lines and bar graphs. In English we have been planning and writing our own Flashbacks and in Science we started our investigation on weight and mass, and how to measure them.

Next week we will continue to learn about rounding numbers to the nearest 100, 1000, 10 000 and 100 000 and read Roman numerals to 1000 (M) and recognise years written in Roman numerals. We will move on to solving number problems involving place value, number order and rounding. In English we will begin our new topic looking at Persuasive writing.

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Year 5

This week we have been learning the value of each digit in a three digit number and ordering the numbers from smallest to largest. We went outside in forest schools to go on a number hunt and arrange some three and four digit numbers in groups. We learnt how the Romans shaped and changed Britain, including building proper roads and bringing over the fruit and vegetables that we know and love today. In science we investigated different sounds and how they are received.

Next week we will be learning how to identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations. In English we will be editing and redrafting our myths.

In year 6 this week we have been learning how to round numbers as well as increasing our confidence when calculating with negative numbers. As part of our topic work we have been finding out about the Silk Road and trading in Baghdad AD 900. In science we have started to learn about famous Arabic scientists as part of our science topic on light.
