Year 3

We have absolutely loved working together this week in Year 3 and 4. We have welcomed a new member to the class and we have all been eagerly introducing them to how we learn at Boroughbridge! We have started to type up our spooky stories after a week of careful editing and we can't wait to spook you with them. In maths we have been solving problems involving commutativity. We had a fantastic science afternoon on Monday where we predicted and then tested different circuits.
