



Dear Nursery families old and new

We hope you are all well and managing to smile most days.

We have really missed you and whilst we have been getting our Reception and Y1 children back for a short time before the Summer, we realise that it will be a long time before we see you in September.

We hope you have been enjoying your learning and we thank you for all the lovely pictures uploaded to Evidence Me and all the hard work that has gone on to support your children at home.

For our new starters we have been not been able to provide our normal transition sessions but this will be a priority as soon as we can.

We are aware that some of you may be shielding and a September start will be something you are concerned about. Do not worry. We will make individual transition plans for those who need it and will liaise with you independently.

Opening Times

From September, when we open, Nursery will be open from 8.30 until 1pm every day. Sessions will be 8.30 until 11.30 and lunch club will run from 11.30 until 1. You may use your 30 hour entitlement towards this, but the 15 hour entitlement is 8.30-11.30. If Government guidance allows, you may be able to share it with another setting. If you would like to purchase a lunch session over and above your entitlement it will be at a cost of £6 for 1 ½ hours, from 11.30-1. You may bring a packed lunch or have a school dinner will be charged at the rate in September.

Transition

Transition will be very carefully managed in September to ensure the well being of all the pupils is prioritised, so it may be staggered. We would love to get everyone in day one but the most important thing is that the children feel happy and safe and you as parents can leave them without any worries.
