This week

What a windy day it was on Thursday, so in Forest Schools we took the opportunity to talk about hurricanes and experimented with kites (a plastic bag and string), bubbles and streamers. The boys imagined the streamers were Spidermans web.

We had a new arrival in class too – a soft toy called Tecza. We found out her name is Polish for rainbow. The children have been writing questions to her and she has been writing back to them individually with the answer. It's been very exciting to find out what she has to say. I wonder if the children can tell you anything they have found out about her?

In maths we have been counting on from a given number (eg 6) to find out how many more we need to make 10. We have been using numicon frames and our fingers to help us.

Over the next few weeks we will continue to count in 2's, 5's and 10's and solving problems in maths. In phonics we have looked at an alternative spelling for "igh" and "ee" specifically "ie" as in "pie" and "ea" as in "read" and "bean". Next week we will look at "oy" and recap sounds learnt so far.
