We have been very impressed with the amount of spontaneous writing the children have been doing throughout the day. This week we have had instructions to plant apple seeds, a letter to Aunt Emma to wish her well, labelled pictures and snowflakes and much more. On a daily basis we pick one “writer of the day” who wears a golden cape the following day!
