This week

This week we listened to the story of “Stick Man” and have enjoyed making and playing with a story box filled with characters and props from the story. Next week we will attempt to retell the story in our own way. We also investigated floating and sinking by searching and sorting objects in Forest Schools.

In maths we have been investigating capacity using the language of **empty and full**. Most children were familiar with this but they were challenged with what was **half full** and practiced this concept by filling a number of different containers with water outside.

In phonics next week we will be learning **oa, ar, or, igh**. Most of the children are starting to recognise the orange tricky words and first few blue tricky words. Next week we will introduce a few more. Remember to keep encouraging them to spot them in books they read and the ones you read to them too. In maths we will be exploring and using the language of subtraction.
