Apologies: Reception

1. Minutes of last meeting agreed
2. It was agreed that Reception should now join the council after their first term at school.
3. Lunchtimes.

After talking to the other children the list from before Christmas for outdoor play was agreed and the following points were added:-

The children would like to play football on the field all year, weather dependent and there should be a rota. If children want to play football they should bring in old trainers and tracksuit bottoms. Without these children can't play. Also, these must not be used for PE. This means there would be no football on the playground.

The rota could be as follows

- a. Monday - Y5/6
- b. Tuesday - Y3/4
- c. Wednesday Y1/2 (Y3/4 to swap with Y1/2)
- d. Thursday - Y5/6
- e. Friday - Y3/4

This is just a suggestion - all KS2 footballers could play on the same day on half a pitch or all together depending on numbers. This needs to be voted on.

Old trainers should be kept near the door so mud isn't walked into school. Mrs Scott to look into suitable storage.

When lunch clubs are on and the children need to get changed the girls and boys would like separate classes to get changed in.

The younger children would like basketball hoops that are at an appropriate height for them - not too high. They would like one on the front playground and two on the back.

The children discussed having a tennis ball for everyone at the start of the year so they could write their names on. If they lost it, then they would have to replace it from home.

The children would also like some places to sit in the shade/out of the rain to read/construct etc when it was winter time, so they are not reliant on trees.

4. It was agreed that we should carry out an audit of equipment with Mrs Goodier and price the following items up.

1. Basketball hoops
2. Basketballs
3. Large hoops
4. Tennis balls
5. Airflow balls
6. Skipping ropes

5. The children suggested that they should be allowed to get their coats from their pegs and go out rather than taking them into the hall. They said that they could be trusted to do this and couldn't see why if some people didn't they should be punished appropriately. They suggested that the only children to take their coats to lunch should be reception. Y1 and 2 could get their coats and go out the hall door. They agreed everyone was sensible enough to do this. Y3,4,5 and 6 should use the KS2 door. This should be the only door open to the outside at the front during lunchtime.

6. Mrs Scott said she would talk to SLT to put some of these things into place for a trial period and also to talk to FOBPS about funding. It was agreed that we may need to fund raise, especially if we were to purchase some outside shelter.
