On Friday 19<sup>th</sup> January Year 5 will be visiting the Tesco store at Clifton Moor in York.

The children will learn about caring for our planet through responsible sourcing of foods such as fish, bananas and cocoa. It will help children consider what sustainability means, and recognise the Fairtrade mark, the Rainforest Alliance logo and what these organisations stand for. They will learn about bananas and how they're grown. They'll investigate whether they are grown in a sustainable way and the sorts of jobs involved in getting them to the supermarket. They will also learn about cocoa - where it comes from, how cocoa beans are grown and whether it is a sustainable crop. They'll also learn about fish and where it comes from, as well as how we can ensure fish stocks are sustainable.

Please make sure your child has a waterproof coat to wear and please make sure you inform me or the school office of any food allergies your child may have. The children will leave the school at 9am and will return in time for their lunch as usual.
