1. Listen to The Jolly Postman by Allan and Janet Ahlberg. Go to https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=gpeo_0yoD0k.

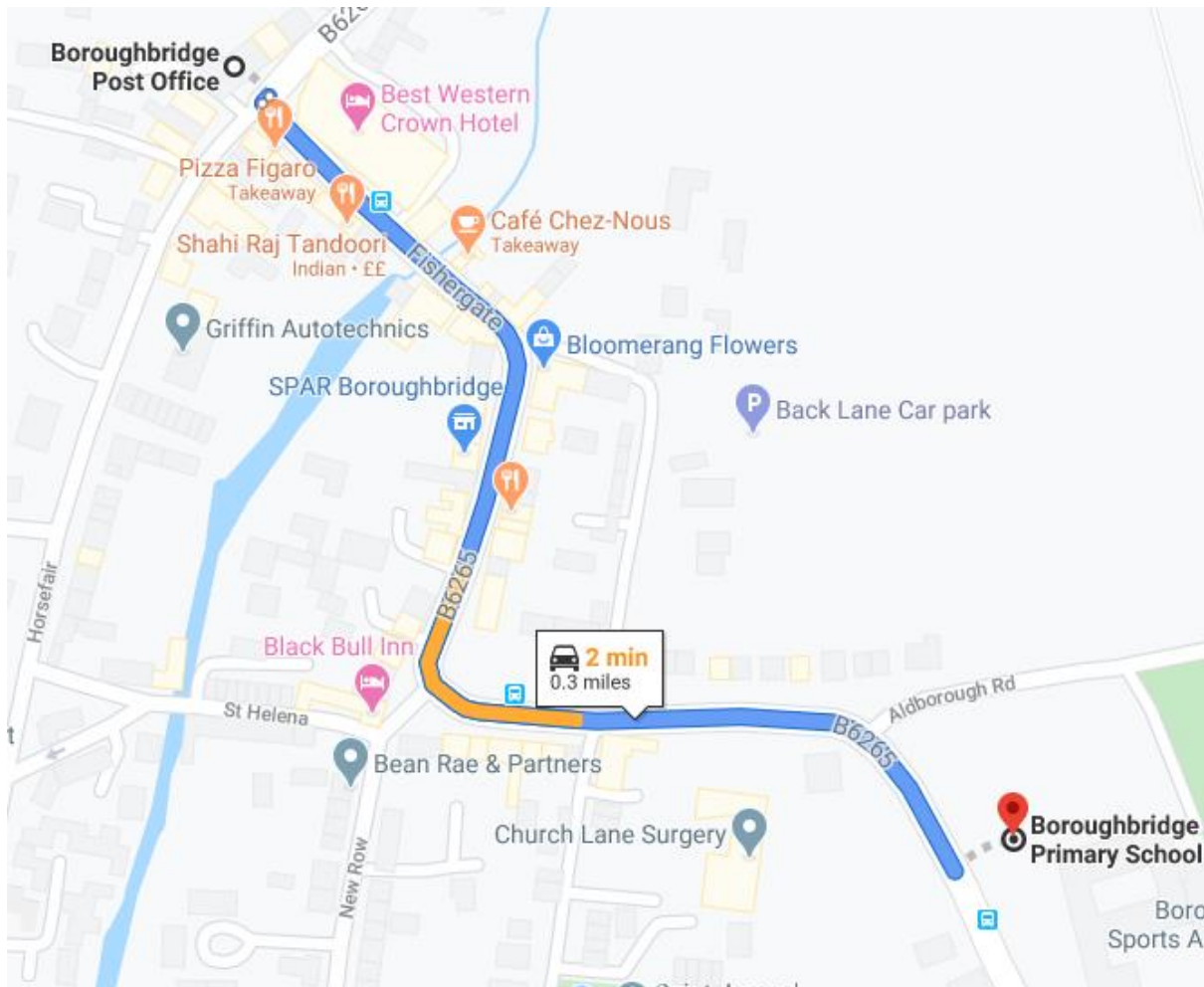
How many stories and nursery rhymes can you find in this story?
