2. Read Dave the Dog is worried about Coronavirus. Supplied as a PDF. Can you design a spotty plaster or a spotty uniform for Nurse Dotty?  
Perhaps you could draw an ambulance or a helicopter like the one in the story.
3. Watch Let's Play - Nurse on iplayer.
